



ICPR 2008 - Call for Tutorials

The ICPR-2008 Tutorial Chairs invite tutorial proposals for the International Conference on Pattern Recognition 2008 (www.icpr2008.org). The tutorials will be held on December 7, immediately before the start of the main conference. Tutorials can be either half a day or full day.

The tutorials may be on topics closely related to the seven tracks of ICPR 2008. Topics from other related fields are also welcome, but the tutorial presenters should state clearly in their proposals how knowledge in these areas can lead to possible collaboration with researchers already working in the core areas of ICPR.

Proposed model is that the speakers will receive 50% of net revenues (after deducting expenses from registration income).
